



*Helping Women Take Control of Their Lives and Move Out of Homelessness*

**HISTORY**

- New Endeavors by Women (NEW) opened in July 1988
- Nearly 1,500 women have received services since NEW opened
- 80% of participants have moved on to independent living

**PROGRAMS**

- *New Endeavors* – offers a complete system of services (see “Services” below) to help women transition out of homelessness
- *New Expectations* – assists homeless pregnant and postpartum women who are dealing with drug and alcohol dependency.
- *Shelter Plus Care* – a Housing and Urban Development (HUD) program that provides private subsidized apartments and supportive services.

- 24-hour residential transition facility
- Advocacy and case management
- Employment counseling
- Academic assistance
- Housing assistance
- Support groups and workshops
- Therapeutic and recreational activities
- Subsidized permanent housing
